

On the occasion of the International Day of Monuments and Sites 2023 the Max-Lingner-Foundation Berlin and the German National Committee of ICOMOS wish to draw attention to the heritage of the «second socialist modernism» (from 1955 until 1990) in architecture and urban development. The reappraisal of the Cold War in the Anglo-Saxon world has prepared this attentiveness in particular. In Eastern European countries, too, there is a growing understanding that beyond the reception of interwar modernism, activated there in part as a cultural resource for the re-emergence of nation states, it is important to address the socialist phase as part of one's own building culture.

In Eastern Europe, the contributions by Dumitru Rusu and the B.A.C.U. Association have had remarkable resonance. With his books of photographs, architectural guides and the website Socialist Modernism, the Romanian architect and his team have greatly promoted knowledge about the architectures of the former socialist countries in recent years. In parallel, a SocHeritage platform has been established within the framework of the International Scientific Committee for the 20th Century (ISC 20C) founded by ICOMOS in Moscow in 2006. The return of military conflicts in Europe and finally Russia's invasion of Ukraine in the spring of 2022 have strengthened a new thinking in blocs and have abruptly interrupted the understanding that had begun about a common recent history and a shared heritage.

The initiative for an International Day for Monuments and Sites (IDMS) on 18 April, launched in 1982 by the International Council on Monuments and Sites (ICOMOS) and taken up by UNESCO, is to be used this year by the Max-Lingner-Foundation in Berlin and ICOMOS Germany with partner organisations as an opportunity to offer experts a cross-border platform for the critical exchange of opinions and experiences. A starting point will be provided by the volumes published so far by Dumitru Rusu and B.A.C.U. — called «Photo Album/Digital Architectural Guide» — regarding the architectural and artistic testimonies of Socialist Modernism in the Baltic States and the Balkans (18 April), in the Russian Federation and Ukraine (19 April), and in Germany (20 April).

Guided tours and walks to monuments and sites of Eastern Modernism in the Berlin and Brandenburg region will complement the workshop programme and are intended to promote dialogue and understanding beyond the present war.
