Preservation and Use of cultural heritage places In Sustainable way

Since becoming a member of ICOMOS-Korea in 2006, I have been engaged with ICOMOS activities as a board member of ICOMOS (2017~present), Vice President of ICOMOS-Korea (2018~present), a board member of ICOMOS-Korea (2009~2017), and a voting member of ICOMOS ICTC (2013~present). I attended 17th (Paris)/ 18th (Florence) General Assembly of ICOMOS, 19th (Delhi)/ 20th (Argentina)/ 21th (Morocco) Board Meeting and General Assembly of ICOMOS, 2013/2014/2015/2018/2019 Conference of ICOMOS ICTC and other international conferences related to preservation and utilization of cultural heritage places. Through these activities, I have become fully aware of ICOMOS goals and wholeheartedly support ICOMOS activities. Based on these experiences, I would like to serve as a Board member of ICOMOS to accomplish the following activities for the next three years.

PRESERVATION AND PROTECTION OF CULTUAL HERITAGE PLACES

- 1. Supporting the preservation and protection activities of valuable cultural heritage sites all around the world, especially in Central Asia: I recognized that World Heritage properties and heritage sites in general are exposed to the impacts of natural and man-triggered catastrophic events, which threaten their integrity and may compromise their value. The loss or deterioration of these outstanding properties has severely negative impacts on local and national communities, both because of their cultural importance, and because of their socioeconomic value.
- 2. Participating in networking between architects, historians and international experts to build the philosophy and doctrine on cultural heritage at an international level respecting cultural and religious

differences: Through ICOMOS ICTC Conference (2013/2014/2015), I realized that the interaction with experts in various fields is important to preservation and protection of cultural heritage places.

- 3. Working on creating the awareness of the importance of preserving valuable cultural heritage places by sharing news and links through social networking sites such as Facebook and Twitter all around world: I found out that SNS was an effective key factor to inform the various activities of ICOMOS related to preservation and protection of cultural heritage places.
- 4. Supporting young professionals to be leaders for preservation and use of cultural heritage places in sustainable way for future generations: We have a responsibility to train young generations to recognize the importance of the cultural heritage preservation including World Heritage.

USE OF CULTURAL HERITAGE PLACES IN SUSTAINABLE WAY

- 1. Supporting the cooperation of host community, conservation practitioners and tourism industry to harmonize conflicting values involved with conservation and use of cultural heritage places: In my experiences related to use of cultural heritage places, it is very essential to balance between conservation and use of cultural heritage places and to create a win-win situation for both sides.
- 2. Supporting and assisting establishment of tourism management plan in many countries, especially in Central Asia: In my experiences working on establishment of tourism management plan of Hwaseong Fortress inscribed as World Heritage in 1997, it is very important to estimate the carrying capacity of cultural heritage places and the number of tourists visiting cultural heritage places, in addition to establishing interpretation manuals, for creating win-win situation between conservation and use of cultural heritage places.
- 3. Working on to improve the physical or cognitive environment to enhance the quality of tourists' experiences at cultural heritage places: Through visiting the cultural heritage sites in many countries during ICOMOS activities, I found out that it was very significant to enhance tourist experiences for conservation and use of cultural heritage sites in sustainable way since the better the experience of visiting the cultural heritage, the more awareness of conservation of cultural heritage becomes.
