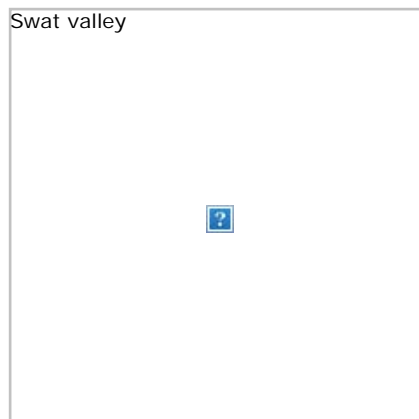

documentary series is online!

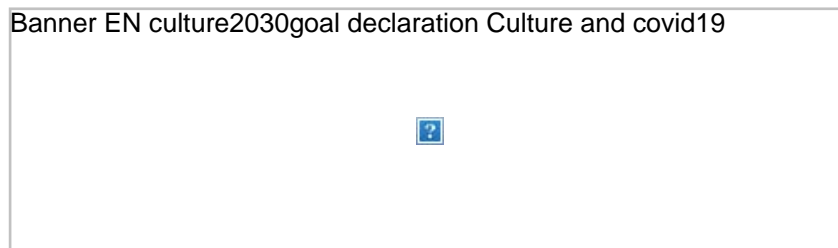

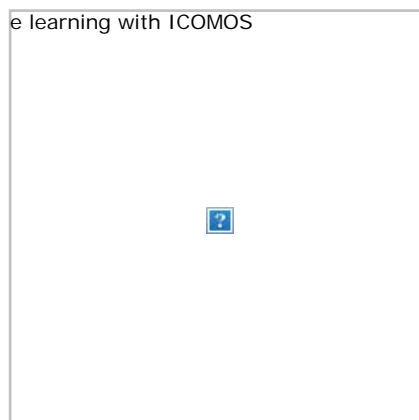

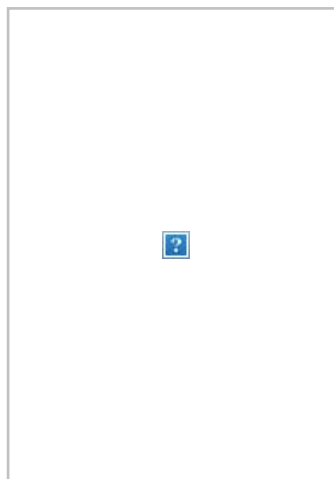
