As a SCO candidate. I have a long standing and deep experience within ICOMOS. I've been an active member of Australia ICOMOS since 1978 and served on the international Executive Committee 1996-2005. I was president of the Advisory Committee in 2015-18 when I was the President of the ISC Twentieth Century Heritage (2005-2017). In 2018 I was elected as a Scientific Council Officer. I'm an active member of the CCHWG and the SDGWG.

If elected as a SCO this will be my final term, as I want to facilitate generational change, to pro-actively engage and support potential future SCO candidates via the AdCom volunteers program. I am willing to stand for election to promote several aspirational projects including:
