Through grants from private foundations, US/ICOMOS expects to offer between 10 and 15 internships overseas in 2008 for U.S. preservationists who are at the early stages of their careers. Through contributions from US host organizations, we also expect to offer between 10 and 15 internships in the United States for non-U.S. citizens.

SEEKING INTERN APPLICANTS

US/ICOMOS internships are geared toward individuals who are in their last year of a relevant graduate program or have been working for 1-3 years in a professional capacity. Successful applicants are those who demonstrate an interest in pursuing preservation work in an international capacity, NOT simply those who need an internship to fulfill a program requirement. The program is very competitive in that only 1 in 5 applicants are awarded internships in any given year. Applications are due January 31, 2008. Please read all information carefully before preparing and submitting an application. Interns must apply to the program as a whole, and not for a specific internship location. Please review the reports on the past three seasons to view the types of internships usually sponsored under this program.

SEEKING HOST ORGANIZATIONS OVERSEAS

US/ICOMOS is seeking additional host organizations overseas for the 2008 International Exchange Program. We raise a limited amount of funds through grants from foundations and donations from private individuals to send about 10 to 12 young American preservationists overseas to work with a variety of preservation organizations in other countries. In order to provide more opportunities, host organizations are needed that can provide housing for the intern and a full or partial stipend for the intern (for food and basic living costs).

SEEKING HOST ORGANIZATIONS IN THE UNITED STATES

US/ICOMOS is also seeking additional host organizations for the 2007 international intern exchange program. U.S. host organizations contribute funds to US/ICOMOS to cover recruitment and processing of intern applications, orientation in Washington for the interns, and distribution of stipends over the course of the internships. US/ICOMOS supplements the host contributions with grants and donations from private individuals.

**The European Archaeological Heritage Prize 2008
CALL FOR NOMINATIONS**

The European Association of Archaeologists instituted the European Archaeological Heritage Prize in 1999.

An independent committee awards the prize annually to an individual, institution or government (local or regional) for an outstanding contribution to the protection and presentation of the European archaeological heritage. In principle, this can be any contribution that is outstanding and of European scope or importance, it does not have to be a scientific contribution. The prize for 2008 will be awarded during the Annual Meeting of the EAA in Valletta, Malta, on Wednesday, 17 September 2008.

The EAA Committee for the European Archaeological Heritage Prize consists of: Anastasia Tourta (Greece), Jürgen Kunow (Germany), Paula Purhonen (Finland), Romuald Schild (Poland) and Willem Willems (the Netherlands; chairperson).

Previous winners of the award include: Manuel Carrilho (Minister of Culture, Portugal, 1999), Margareta Björnstad (State Antiquarian of Sweden, 2000), Otto Braasch (Germany, 2001), Henry Cleere (United Kingdom 2002), Viktor Trifonov (Russia, 2003), Illicit Antiquities Research Centre (IARC)(Europe, 2004), Kristian Kristiansen (Denmark/ Sweden, 2005), John Coles (United Kingdom 2006), Siegmund von Schnurbein (Germany, 2007).

The Committee will discuss all serious proposals for the award. Nominations may be made by any of the following:

- Members of the Association (all grades of membership)
- Professors and heads of departments of archaeology in European universities and institutes
- Directors of governmental heritage management organisations and agencies in European countries (members of the Council of Europe)
- Non-governmental archaeological, heritage and professional organisations in European countries

**Annual IAIA Conference - International Association for Impact Assessment
Workshop on "Cultural heritage and impact assessment
4-10 May 2008, Perth, Western Australia**

Environmental Impact Assessment (EIA) and Strategic Environmental Assessment (SEA) are intended to provide an integrated analysis of the biophysical, social and cultural heritage impacts of development projects or strategies. Methods for identifying and considering biophysical and social

conditions and impacts are established; information and experienced professionals are generally available. However, in many parts of the world, the cultural heritage aspect of EIA and SEA is considerably less well developed.

The separation of cultural and environmental practitioners in most countries has resulted in a lack of experience and a scarcity of methods and tools for addressing cultural heritage in EIA and SEA. Various types of institutions recognize the need for strengthening the cultural heritage component of impact assessment and have a role; they include: international and regional development agencies, national governments, private corporations, EIA consulting firms, and cultural organizations.

A workshop on "Cultural heritage and impact assessment" has been included in the program of the annual conference of IAIA (International Association for Impact Assessment), that will be held from May 4-10, 2008, in Perth, Western Australia.

Applications for the **Advanced Masters in Structural Analysis of Monuments and Historical Constructions**, approved and financially sponsored by the European Commission within the framework of the Erasmus Mundus Programme, have just opened.
