UNESCO study on international law and mobility of artists, artworks, cultural goods and services

ICOMOS members are invited to respond in their individual professional capacity

UNESCO has commissioned Richard Poláček, together with Judith Staines, to make a short research project in January/February 2009. This study will provide an overview of the main international legal instruments plus examples of bilateral and multilateral cooperation agreements from around the world with an impact on the mobility of artists, artworks, cultural goods and services. It will also examine obstacles to mobility, present examples of good practice and propose strategies and actions for policy- and decision-makers.

The study was commissioned in the framework of additional assistance to the Intergovernmental Committee for the Protection and Promotion of Cultural Diversity, and as part of the follow up of the Recommendation concerning the Status of the Artist (UNESCO, 1980). The final report is intended as an advocacy document examining wider impacts of policy and legislation on the international circulation of artists and their works.
