## Celebration of the 10th Anniversary of ICOMOS-KOREA



Marking its 10th anniversary, ICOMOS-KOREA held a commemorative symposium on Friday 17 April 2009. Gustavo Araoz, President of ICOMOS International, was present to celebrate the occasion and give a keynote presentation on "ICOMOS and Cultural Heritage". On behalf of all the members of ICOMOS-KOREA I would like to extend my deep gratitude to him.

In commemoration of the anniversary, two lectures were held: A lecture on the Jeju Volcanic Island and Lava Tubes, and one on the Experience of the Inspection of Yin Xu. Both of the sites had been inscribed on the World Heritage List in 2007 and 2006 respectively. The event also saw the announcement of the publication "A decade of ICOMOS-KOREA, 1999-2009: Accomplishments and Visions". Members shared memorable moments from the past 10 years while watching a slide show. The celebration culminated in the proclamation of the "ICOMOS-KOREA VISION 2020", which was proposed as a firm resolution to further strengthen ICOMOS Korea's activities as a leading professional NGO to preserve and protect the cultural heritage. Its main goals are as follows:

### ICOMOS-KOREA VISION 2020

1. Advancing International Activities
2. Enhancing National Activities
3. Improving Conservation and Management Systems
4. Expanding General Understanding of the World Heritage
5. Invigorating Research and Development Activities

ICOMOS-KOREA will continue to expand its activities, domestically and internationally, corresponding with its mission to preserve and protect the cultural heritage.

On the morning of the 18th April, Mr. Araoz took a tour of the Jongmyo and Chandeokgung Palaces which are both inscribed on the World Heritage List. He said that he was deeply impressed with the preparatory process of the Grand Ancestral Rite of Jongmyo, which is also one of the Masterpieces of Oral and Intangible Heritage of Humanity. In the afternoon, he had an opportunity to relish the

cultural essence of Korea when visiting the National Museum of Korea. He met with the Director of the museum, Choi Kwang-sik. In the evening before Mr. Araoz left for The United States, ICOMOS-KOREA held a farewell dinner for him and exchanged views on a variety of item on ICOMOS' agenda.

The members of ICOMOS-KOREA and I will promote our effort to continue to play an active role as a leading professional NGO in the region.

## **Planned Conservation of XXth Century Architectural Heritage: A Review of Policies and Practices**

**30-31 October 2009, Como (Italy)**

Como City Council is the owner and manager of several important monuments of Modern Architecture. The Council is setting up innovative practices for their planned conservation and their enhancement with the sponsorship and contribution of Fondazione Cariplo, in the framework of the project 'Innovative Technologies for Planned Conservation of Built Cultural Heritage'.

The conference is part of this project and will have two main purposes. Firstly it will focus on the most up to date status of Planned Conservation: presentations and discussions will highlight researches, policies and practices necessary for an effective conservation of XXth century architectural heritage. - inspection and monitoring as preventive conservation tools for architectural heritage
- sustainability issues of preventive conservation of XXth century architectural heritage
